Dr. Djalal is known for his distinguished career in Indonesian public service, and is a prominent civil society leader, public thinker, academic, and author. His intellectual leadership and innovative diplomacy have been credited with advancing Indonesia’s global reputation as a progressive, influential, and dynamic nation.

Prior to his role as ambassador, Dr. Djalal served as Special Staff for International Affairs and Presidential Spokesperson for President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono. He joined the department of Foreign Affairs

of Indonesia in 1987 and has been posted to Timor Leste, London, and Washington D.C. as Director for North American Affairs. He has led initiatives such as the U.S. - Indonesia Security Dialogue, the Global Inter-Media Dialogue, and the Presidential Visitor’s Program. He is also the author of several best-selling books, including *Harus Bisa!*, which has had 1.7 million copies printed. Dino Djalal is married to Dr. Rosa Rai Djalal, and they are blessed with three young children: Alexa, Keanu and Chloe. ■

George Vradenburg

George Vradenburg is a civic activist and philanthropist, driven by a passion for public service. President of the Vradenburg Foundation, he founded USAgainstAlzheimer’s, a national disease advocacy network and chairs the Geoffrey Beene Foundation-Alzheimer’s Initiative on early diagnosis. Vradenburg is also Chairman of the Board of The Phillips Collection in Washington, DC, a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, the Economic Club, and Co-Founder and Vice Chairman of the Chesapeake Crescent Initiative.

Prior to December 2003, he was Strategic Advisor, AOL Time Warner, having served in senior executive

positions at AOL, AOL Time Warner and Time Warner. Before joining America Online, Mr. Vradenburg served as Senior Vice President and General Counsel of CBS Inc. and Executive Vice President of Fox, Inc.

Mr. Vradenburg received his B.A. from Oberlin College, magna cum laude, where he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa, and his J.D. cum laude from Harvard Law School. His wife, Trish, is a TV sitcom writer, a playwright, book author and magazine and newspaper columnist. Mr. Vradenburg is an IFE Steward in addition to being the first recipient of the IFE Leadership Award. ■



Special Guest Speaker

The Honorable Mark Warner, United States Senator (D-VA)

Mark Warner was elected to the U.S. Senate in November 2008, and serves on the Senate Banking, Budget, Commerce and Intelligence committees. After almost four years in the Senate, Senator Warner has established himself as a national leader in efforts to find bipartisan consensus to create balanced solutions to reduce the federal debt. He also has been a champion for military men and women, their families, and our military veterans. Senator Warner also is a leader in Congress in efforts to promote private-sector innovation and to help our nation’s small businesses and start-up companies succeed.

From 2002 to 2006, Senator Warner served as Governor of Virginia, where he worked in a bipartisan way to turn record budget deficits into a surplus. Governor Warner also focused on improving public education and expanding economic opportunity in every region of the state. He recruited 135,000 new jobs to Virginia during his four-year term. When Governor Warner left office in 2006, Virginia was consistently recognized as the nation’s “best-managed state,” the “best state for business” and the state offering the best educational opportunities to its young people. Senator Warner, his wife Lisa Collis, and their three daughters live in Alexandria, Virginia. ■

GLOBAL COMPASS LEADERSHIP AWARD

The **Global Compass Leadership Award** is given to an IFE intern, fellow, or other outstanding young person who has demonstrated, on a sustained basis, exceptional leadership, initiative, innovative thinking, and entrepreneurship in enhancing global perspectives, understanding, and connectivity.

Jenny Shore, the first recipient of the Global Compass Leadership Award, is the Founder of NEXT GEN and an IFE intern. She has studied Arabic, Hebrew, and French at an advanced level. In addition, she is a classically trained pianist who has played at embassies and other prominent locations throughout Washington, DC. Following her high school graduation last May, she interned at Al Jazeera Arabic. Currently, she is an intern at CBS News' "60 Minutes." Jenny plans to attend college in the fall and recently was accepted at Harvard University.

NEXT GEN is a forum for Institute for Education interns and D.C. area high school and college students to meet with national and international political, business, and cultural leaders to exchange ideas with impact.

NEXT GENers have frank and open discussions with game changers to learn about future trends and opportunities in an expanding global environment. NEXT GEN partners with the Pulitzer Center on Crisis Reporting and is modeled after IFE's flagship program, INFO Public Policy Roundtable, which is a mainstay in the Washington public policy arena, having hosted more than 250 prominent thought leaders as speakers over the past two decades.
