H.E. PISAN MANAWAPAT

Pisan Manawapat is the 44th Thai ambassador to the United States. Before arriving in Washington in February 2015, he served as Thai ambassador to Belgium, Luxembourg and the European Union (2007-2011), India (2011-2013) and Canada (2013-2015). Ambassador Manawapat's first overseas posting was in Washington (1986-1990), where he spent his first 12 months on Capitol Hill as APSA Congressional Fellow in the offices of U.S. Rep. Don Pease (D-OaH) and Sen. Daniel Inouye (D-HI). He then served in Kuala Lumpur from 1993-1995 and as Deputy Chief of Mission in Tokyo (1999-2002). From 2002-2004, he assumed the position of the Director-General of the Department of International Economic Affairs, and the Ministry's Deputy Permanent Secretary supervising all of Thailand's bilateral relations from 2004 to 2007. Ambassador Manawapat won a Foreign Ministry scholarship to study Economics in the U.K. He graduated with B.Sc. (Econ) and M.Sc. (Econ), majoring in International Trade, from the London School of Economics and Political Science, in 1980 and 1981 respectively. He is married to Wanchana Manawapat and has one daughter.

Named Washington's "Networker in Chief" by *U.S. News* and *World Report*, Coach is the founder and CEO of the Institute for Education. Her writing is regularly featured in *USA Today*, *Roll Call*, *The Washington Examiner* and *Newsday*.
