

Yoshitaka Ikeda is a member of the Cabinet Office's Council of Experts on Fusion Strategy. He is currently the member of the QST associate who advises the QST activities. QST is the ITER Japan Domestic Agency and the Japanese implementing agency for BA activities (EU-Japan Collaboration projects).

He had been the Managing Director of QST Fusion Energy Directorate until this past March.

He joined the JT-60 project at Naka Fusion Institute forty years ago, 1985. He worked on the developments of heating system and on the plasma heating experiments in JT-60 project.

After the start of the BA activities in 2007, he conducted the disassemble of JT-60 tokamak for the JT-60SA, and the construction of JT-60SA as the manager in charge.

From 2018 to 2021, we worked as the Director General of the Rokkasho Fusion Institute where the developments of the fast neutron source, blankets and the design of DEMO reactor are being carried out.

He worked as the Director Genal of Naka fusion institute from 2021 to 2022 to manage the QST contributions to the ITER and JT-60SA. And then he had worked as the Managing Director till this March to direct the fusion energy activity of QST.
